

Requirements



All dogs must have a complete and up to date vaccination record. No dogs under court orders can be accepted in the home board programme.

Feeding regimes will be continuous; in that times, quantities and frequency will relate directly to the way in which the routines would be carried out at home. Treats and titbits would only be offered should this be requested and agreed by the owner. All such feed to be provided by the owners at time of arrival. Bedding and food bowls are provided as are toys and chew things.

Crating of dogs, should this be something your dog is used to, can be continued but you may need to provide that crate.

Payment in full at time of arrival, rates are per day or part thereof. Current medical conditions requiring continued assessment, care or administration of medication will be continued in accordance with your requirements.
